



Candy Heart Pocket Tag

Our darling gift tag has a pocket just big enough to hold a chocolate treat, love note, or gift card. With techniques like applique and lining in-the-hoop, this sweet project really is as fun to make as it is to give.

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Materials Needed:

HOOP: 4 x 4

(Embroidery Field Needed: 3.90 x 3.88)

Finished size: 3 x 3³/₄"

STABILIZER: Cut-away Stabilizer

FABRIC:

Make one tag from fabric scraps or cut enough fabric for four tags from a Fat Sixteenth.

Fabric 1: (pocket front)	1 Fat Sixteenth
Fabric 2: (back of tag)	1 Fat Sixteenth
Fabric 3: (inside pocket)	1 Fat Sixteenth
Fabric 4: (heart)	1 Fat Sixteenth

OTHER:

³/₈" button

¹/₈" wide Ribbon or Baker's twine 12"

OPTIONAL:

³/₈" wide Ribbon (bow) 12"

A Fat Sixteenth is 9 x 11"

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric 1:	cut (1) 3 ¹ / ₂ x 5" block
Fabric 2:	cut (1) 3 ¹ / ₂ x 5" block
Fabric 3:	cut (1) 3 ¹ / ₂ x 5" block
Fabric 4:	cut (1) 2 ¹ / ₂ x 3" block

Prepare the Following:

Fold Fabric 1 (pocket front) in half, **wrong sides together**, with the 3¹/₂" sides touching. Iron a crease in the fabric at the fold.



Embroider the Following:

1. Hoop stabilizer only in the appropriate size hoop.



Corresponds with the specific embroidery machine step.



Indicates thread color change.
