 Choose to stitch in just one color like traditional redwork, or applique your favorite fabric for the frosting top and embellish with a cherry red button.

Materials Needed:

HOOP: 5 x 7 hoop
 (Embroidery Field Needed: 4.14 x 6.40)

STABILIZER: Self-adhesive Stabilizer

OTHER:
 Cardstock Card (approximately 8 x 11")

OPTION 1: REDWORK

Redwork only with one color of thread.

OPTION 2: APPLIQUE DESIGN

Appliqued "frosting" piece as well as color stops for each section of redwork.

Fabric 1: (cupcake) scrap fabric or 3 x 4" piece
 1/2" red button

Embroider the Following:

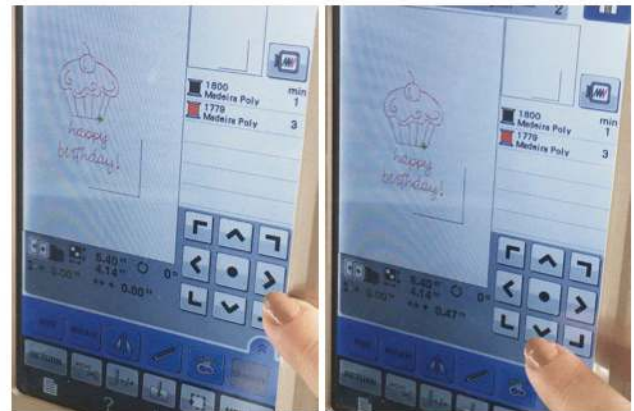
1. Hoop stabilizer only with **paper side up**, in the appropriate size hoop.



2. Using the tip of your scissors, score the stabilizer inside the perimeter of the hoop. Peel paper away from the scored section exposing the stabilizer adhesive.



3. Using your machine settings, move the design to the **bottom** of the hoop and all the way to the **right**. This will allow more room for the card to lay flat.



Corresponds with the specific embroidery machine step.



Indicates thread color change.
