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Materials Needed:

HOOP: 5 x 7

(Embroidery Field Needed: 4.69 x 4.69)

STABILIZER: Self-adhesive water soluble stabilizer

OTHER:

Dinner Napkin (approximately 18" square)

Embroider the Following:

1. Hoop stabilizer only with **paper side up** in the appropriate size hoop.



2. Using the tip of your scissors, score the stabilizer inside the perimeter of the hoop. Peel paper away from the scored section exposing the stabilizer adhesive.



3. Stitch the first step: **the corner basting stitches** directly on the stabilizer adhesive.



Corresponds with the specific embroidery machine step.



Indicates thread color change.
