



Machine Embroider by Number: {Love at Home}

Heart-shaped wisps of smoke coming from the chimney say there is “Love at Home” in this Kimberbell original Embroidery by Number project. Crosshatch quilting on the large and medium sizes is sewn to perfection in-the-hoop with optional ribbon loops for hanging the little quilt. The small size is just right for a pin cushion or ornament.

Materials Needed: SMALL

HOOP: 4 x 4
 (Embroidery Field Needed: 3.56 x 3.61)
 Finished Size: 3 1/2 x 3 1/2”

STABILIZER: Cut-away stabilizer

Fabric 1: (borders and back)	1 Fat Eighth
Fabric 2: (background fabric)	4 x 10”
Fabric 3: (house)	4 x 6”
Fabric 4: (roof)	3 x 5”
Fabric 5: (door)	3 x 3”

OTHER:
 Batting 5 x 5”

A Fat Eighth is 9 x 21”
 A Fat Quarter is 18 x 21”

Cutting Instructions: SMALL

Fabric 1: (borders and back)
 Cut **(2)** 5 x 5” (outside backing pieces)
 Cut **(2)** 3 x 1 1/2” (border pieces 10 & 11)
 Cut **(2)** 4 1/2 x 1 1/2 (border pieces 12 & 13)

Fabric 2: (background)
 Cut **(2)** 2 1/2 x 2 1/2” (background pieces 8 & 9)
 Cut **(2)** 1 1/2 x 2 1/2” (background pieces 5 & 6)

Fabric 3: (house)
 Cut **(3)** 2 1/2 x 1 1/2” (house pieces 2, 3, & 4)

Fabric 4: (roof)
 Cut **(1)** 2 x 3 1/2” (roof piece 7)

Fabric 5: (door)
 Cut **(1)** 2 x 2” (door piece 1)

Materials Needed: MEDIUM

HOOP: 6 x 10
 (Embroidery Field Needed: 5.70 x 6.20)
 Finished Size: 5 1/2 x 5 1/2”

STABILIZER: Cut-away stabilizer

Fabric 1: (borders and back)	1 Fat Quarter
Fabric 2: (background fabric)	5 x 10”
Fabric 3: (house)	5 x 7”
Fabric 4: (roof)	6 x 4”
Fabric 5: (door)	4 x 4”

OTHER:
 Batting: 8 x 8”
 Optional Ribbon Loops: (2) 2” pieces
 Small black button (optional for door knob)

(Note to Bernina® Users: You will need to use the MEGA HOOP (150mm x 400mm) approximately 5.9 x 15.8”)

Cutting Instructions: MEDIUM

Fabric 1: (borders and back)
 Cut **(2)** 8 x 8” (outside backing pieces)
 Cut **(2)** 5 1/2 x 1 1/2” (border pieces 10 & 11)
 Cut **(2)** 7 x 1 1/2 (border pieces 12 & 13)

Fabric 2: (background)
 Cut **(2)** 4 x 2 1/2” (background pieces 8 & 9)
 Cut **(2)** 3 1/2 x 2” (background pieces 5 & 6)

Fabric 3: (house)
 Cut **(3)** 4 x 2” (house pieces 2, 3, & 4)

Fabric 4: (roof)
 Cut **(1)** 5 1/2 x 3” (roof piece 7)

Fabric 5: (door)
 Cut **(1)** 3 x 3” (door piece 1)



Corresponds with the specific embroidery machine step.



Indicates thread color change.
