# Materials Needed: LARGE

#### HOOP: 8 x 8

(Embroidery Field Needed: 7.31 x 7.85)

Finished Size: 7 x 7"

# **STABILIZER:** Cut-away stabilizer

Fabric 1: (borders and back) 1 Fat Quarter Fabric 2: (background fabric) 1 Fat Sixteenth

Fabric 3: (house) 6 x 7"
Fabric 4: (roof) 7 x 5"
Fabric 5: (door) 5 x 4"

#### OTHER:

Batting: 9 x 9"
Optional Ribbon Loops (2) 2" pieces
Small black button (optional for door knob)

#### **Cutting Instructions: LARGE**

#### Fabric 1: (borders and back)

Cut (2) 9 ½ x 9 ½" (outside backing pieces)

Cut (2) 7 x 1 ½" (border pieces 10 & 11)

Cut (2) 8 ½ x 1 ½ (border pieces 12 & 13)

# Fabric 2: (background)

Cut (2) 5 1/2 x 4 1/2" (background pieces 8 & 9)

Cut (2) 4 ½ x 2 ½ (background pieces 5 & 6)

# Fabric 3: (house)


Cut (3) 5 x 2" (house pieces 2, 3, &4)

# Fabric 4: (roof)

Cut (1) 6 1/2 x 4" (roof piece 7)

#### Fabric 5: (door)

Cut (1) 4 x 3" (door piece 1)



# Embroider the Following

Hoop stabilizer only, in the appropriate size hoop.




Stitch the first step: **the placement line**directly onto the stabilizer. Place the oversized piece of batting on top of the stabilizer. Be sure the box is completely covered.







Stitch the next step: the **house piecing template.** This is stitched on top of the batting.



**NOTE:** All stitching will be done **on top** of the batting. Do not cut the batting until the final step.
