#### Materials Needed: SMALL

**HOOP:** 4 x 4

(Embroidery Field Needed: 2.62 x 3.88)

Finished Size: 21/2 x 33/4"

**STABILIZER:** Cut-away Stabilizer

FABRIC:

Fabric 1: (main fabric) 1 Fat Eighth Fabric 2: (lining) 1 Fat Eighth

OTHER:

Zipper (at least 6")

Batting

Paper Tape

3/8" wide Ribbon

Metal key ring (optional)

A Fat Eighth is 9 x 21"

#### **Cutting Instructions: SMALL**

 Fabric 1:
 cut (3) 5 x 5" blocks

 Fabric 2:
 cut (3) 5 x 5" blocks

 Batting:
 cut (1) 5 x 5" block

 Ribbon:
 cut (1) 2" piece

## Prepare the Following:

Take two Fabric 1 (main fabric) pieces. Fold one edge down approximately 1" with wrong sides together. Iron to make a crisp fold. Repeat with one remaining Fabric 1 piece and two Fabric 2 (lining) pieces.

### Materials Needed: MEDIUM

**HOOP:** 5 x 7

(Embroidery Field Needed: 3.26 x 4.52)

Finished Size: 3 x 4 3/8"

**STABILIZER:** Cut-away Stabilizer

#### **FABRIC:**

Fabric 1: (main fabric) 1 Fat Eighth Fabric 2: (lining) 1 Fat Eighth

#### OTHER:

Zipper (at least 7")

Batting
Paper Tape

3/8" wide Ribbon

Metal key ring (optional)

A Fat Eighth is 9 x 21"

### Cutting Instructions: MEDIUM

Fabric 1: cut (3) 6 x 6" blocks Fabric 2: cut (3) 6 x 6" blocks Batting: cut (1) 6 x 6" block Ribbon: cut (1) 2" piece







Corresponds with the specific machine embroidery step
