10 Fat Quarters for Front and Backing Fabric

1/4 yard for pockets

 $^{1\!\!/}_{4}$ yard for lining

Two 1/8 yard pieces for handles (or make scrappy with remaining fat quarter scraps)

The blocks outlined in red and yellow indicate the location of pockets. Pockets are covering blocks B2, C2, D2, B5, C5 and D5.

The yellow line indicates where the pocket openings will be.

The yellow line indicates where the top of the pocket is.

*Pockets B5, C5 and D5 will stitch in the hoop 'upside down'.



Weekender Bag Handles

To complete the handles for the bag you will need to gather 2 different fabrics and your pre-cut handles of HOOPShape. Follow these instructions to complete 2 handle straps for your bag.

Fabric 1: cut 2 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric

Fabric 2: cut 2 strips 1³⁄₈" x width of fabric

HOOPShape™ Pre-cut handles or two 1⅔" x 40"

Once your fabric is cut you will need to layer the 3 pieces to begin stitching.

First, lay HOOPShape[™]. Next, place Fabric 2 right side up on top of HOOPShape[™]. Last, place Fabric 1 right side down. Make your HOOPShape[™] approximately 1" shorter than fabric on both ends.

Fabric 2, right side up (1%" x wof)	HOOPShape™
Echric Lirichtsido down (21/2" x weft	Fabric 2, right side up (1 % " x wof)
Eabric 1 right side down (214" x wof)	
	Fabric 1, right side down (2½" x wof)

Align raw edges on one side and stitch that side using a $\frac{1}{2}$ seam allowance.

Insert a long piece of selvage between Fabric 1 and 2, to help with turning. Skip if using Fast Turn.

Next, align the raw edges on the opposite side. Stitch using ¼" seam allowance. Stitch across one short end of strap if using selvage to turn.

Turn the piece inside out by gently tugging on selvage strip or use a Fast Turn tube large enough to fit between Fabric 1 and Fabric 2. The HOOPShape™ will be between the fabric and all seams hidden after turning!



Straight stitch or decorative stitch in the ditch on both sides to complete your strap. Repeat steps for second strap!

Weekender Bag

It is recommended that you mark, on the stabilizer, the block that you are stitching. Once stabilizer is removed, mark the top of the block inside the seam allowance.

A1/A4 A3/A6 E1/E4 E3/E6 Hoop tearaway stabilizer. Place water soluble thread in the needle and embroidery bobbin thread in the bobbin. Sew placement stitches. 4.) A1/A4 A3/A6 E1/E4 E3/E6 Stitch quilting using embroidery thread in the color of your choice.	A1/A4 A3/A6 E1/E4 E3/E6 Align HoopShape Pre-Cut™ and sew tack down using water soluble thread.
