Travel Slippers Upper (Toe Area)

<p>1.)</p>  <p>Left Right</p> <p>Hoop Stabilizer. Place <u>water soluble thread</u> in the needle and embroidery bobbin thread in the bobbin. Sew the placement stitches.</p>	<p>2.)</p>  <p>Left Right</p> <p>Place <u>HOOPShape™</u> pre-cut over placement stitches. Using <u>water soluble thread</u> sew the zigzag stitches to attach the HOOPShape™ to the stabilizer.</p>	<p>3.)</p>  <p>Left Right</p> <p>Place your <u>first piece of fabric</u> over this section, leaving at least $\frac{1}{2}$" over the outside edges. Tack down using <u>water soluble thread</u>. Trim to $\frac{1}{4}$" on inside of piece.</p>
<p>4.)</p>  <p>Left Right</p> <p>Place <u>next piece of fabric</u> right side down, raw edges even with the previous piece. Using <u>neutral thread</u> in the needle, sew the seam.</p>	<p>5.)</p>  <p>Left Right</p> <p>Flip the fabric right side up, finger press and smooth out. With neutral thread, sew the tack down. Fabric Supply List for Scrappy Bag

10 Fat Quarters for Front and Backing Fabric

¼ yard for pockets

¼ yard for lining

Two ⅓ yard pieces for handles (or make scrappy with remaining fat quarter scraps)

Use same cutting instructions in above table.

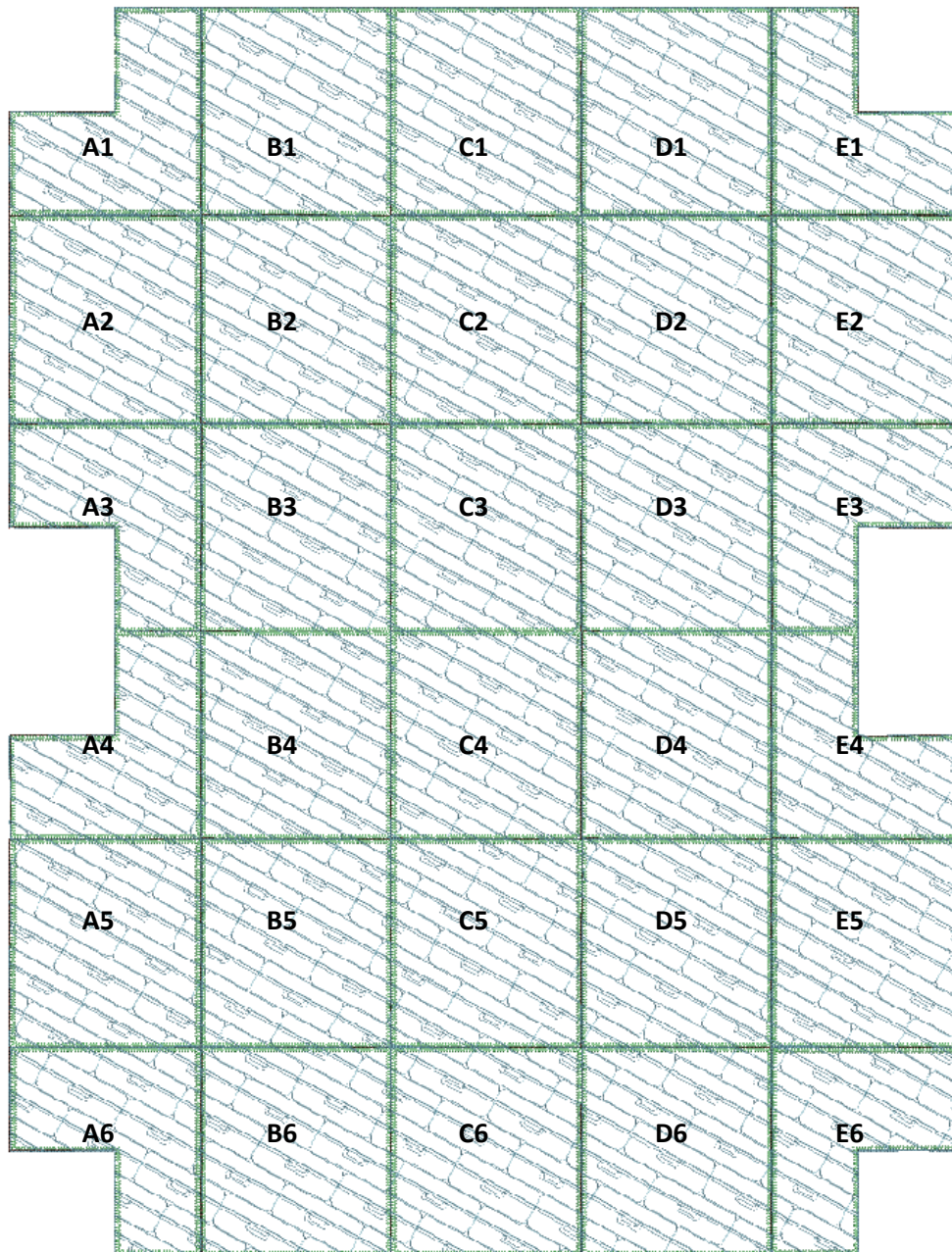


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Weekender Bag Layout—(Without Pockets)

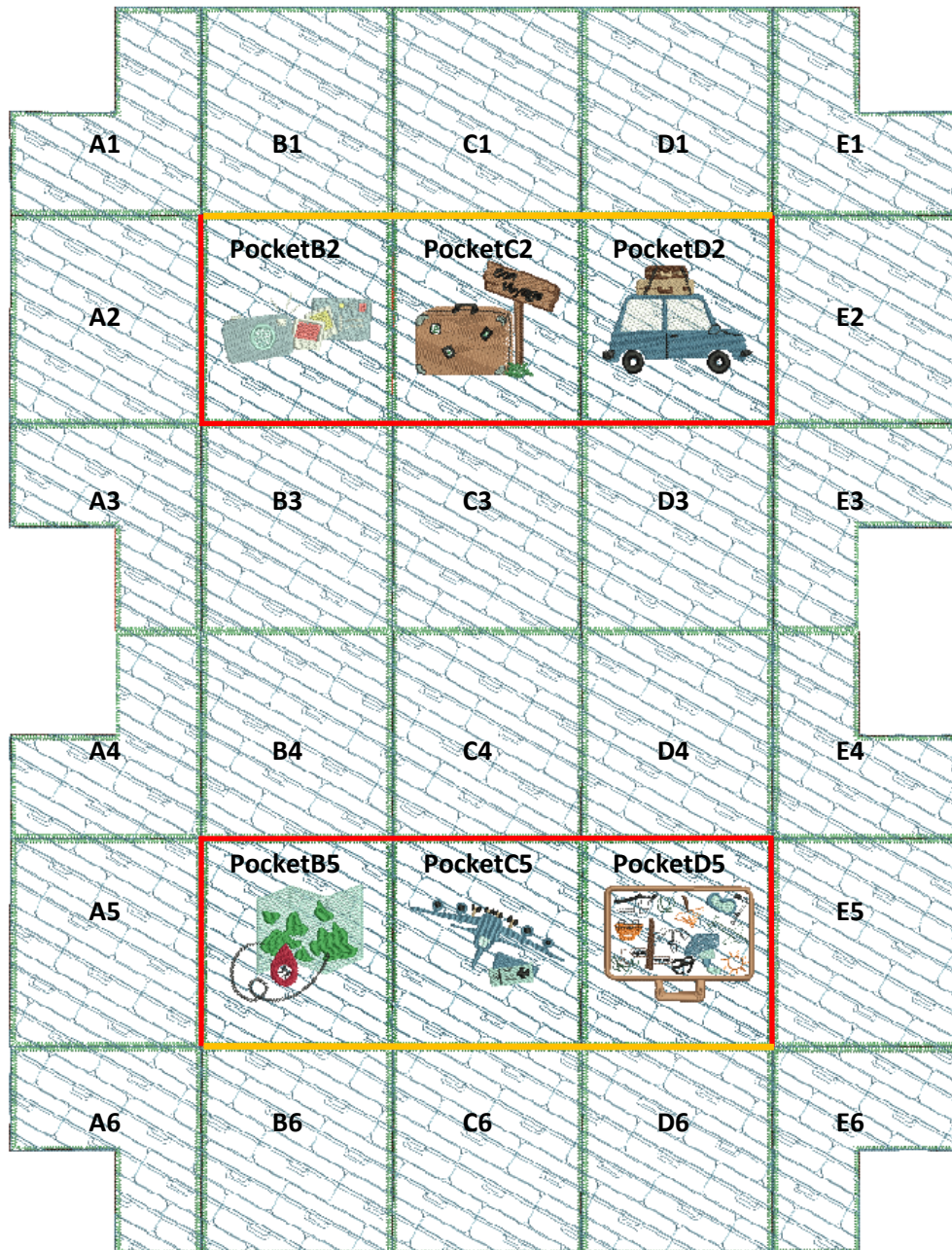


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Weekender Bag Layout—With Pockets

The blocks outlined in red and yellow indicate the location of pockets. Pockets are covering blocks B2, C2, D2, B5, C5 and D5.

The yellow line indicates where the pocket openings will be.

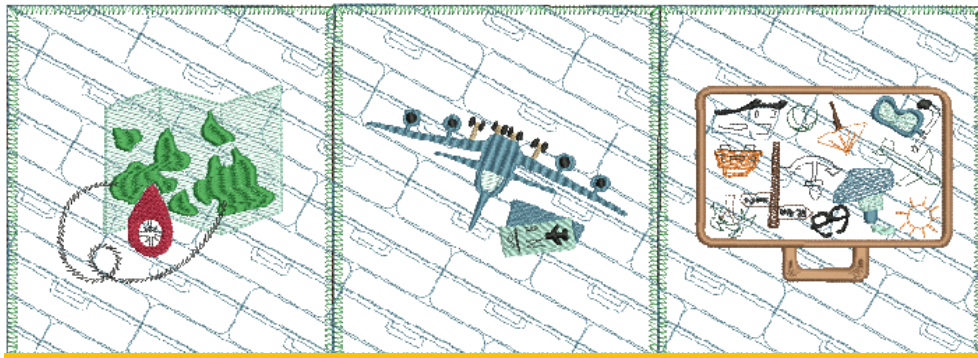

*Pockets B5, C5 and D5 will stitch in the hoop 'upside down'.

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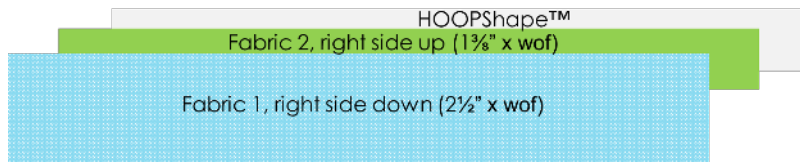
Weekender Bag Handles

To complete the handles for the bag you will need to gather 2 different fabrics and your pre-cut handles of HOOPShape. Follow these instructions to complete 2 handle straps for your bag.

Fabric 1: cut 2 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric
Fabric 2: cut 2 strips $1\frac{3}{8}$ " x width of fabric
HOOPShape™ Pre-cut handles or two $1\frac{3}{8}$ " x 40"

Once your fabric is cut you will need to layer the 3 pieces to begin stitching.

First, lay HOOPShape™. Next, place Fabric 2 right side up on top of HOOPShape™. Last, place Fabric 1 right side down. Make your HOOPShape™ approximately 1" shorter than fabric on both ends.



Align raw edges on one side and stitch that side using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Insert a long piece of selvage between Fabric 1 and 2, to help with turning. Skip if using Fast Turn.

Next, align the raw edges on the opposite side. Stitch using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Stitch across one short end of strap if using selvage to turn.

Turn the piece inside out by gently tugging on selvage strip or use a Fast Turn tube large enough to fit between Fabric 1 and Fabric 2. The HOOPShape™ will be between the fabric and all seams hidden after turning!



Straight stitch or decorative stitch in the ditch on both sides to complete your strap. Repeat steps for second strap!

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



Weekender Bag

It is recommended that you mark, on the stabilizer, the block that you are stitching. Once stabilizer is removed, mark the top of the block inside the seam allowance.

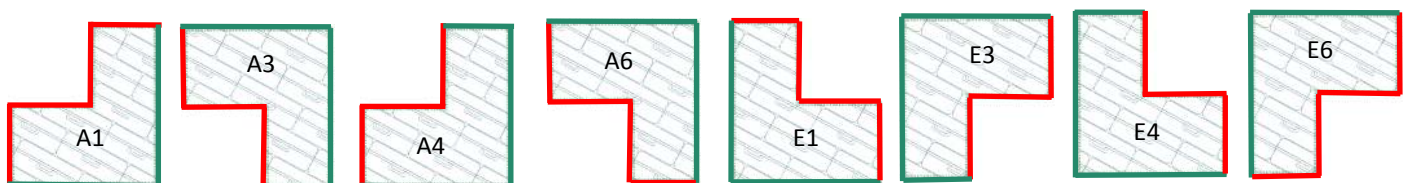
<p>1.)</p>  <p>Hoop <u>tearaway stabilizer</u>. Place <u>water soluble thread</u> in the needle and embroidery bobbin thread in the bobbin. Sew placement stitches.</p>	<p>2.)</p>  <p>Align <u>HoopShape Pre-Cut™</u> and sew tack down using <u>water soluble thread</u>.</p>	<p>3.)</p>  <p>Place <u>Backing Fabric</u> on the back of the hoop, using spray adhesive, if necessary. Place <u>Front Fabric</u> on the front of the hoop and sew tack down using <u>water soluble thread</u>.</p>
<p>4.)</p>  <p>Stitch quilting using <u>embroidery thread</u> in the color of your choice.</p>		

How to Trim Blocks:

A1, A3, A4, A6, E1, E1, E4, E6

Where block is marked red—trim through all layers to ¼”.

Where block is marked green—trim away backing using Trimmer 2.0. Then, trim front fabric to ¼”.
