2.97" w x 2.82" h



Step 1,
Stitch center 'B' using orange thread.



Step 2,
Stitch first 'B' and flames using yellow thread.



Step 3,
Using red thread, stitch 'Q' and flames.

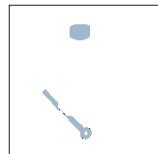


Step 4,
Sew 'BBQ Boss' using black thread.

Step 1,
Stitch brush handle and bottle cap using gray thread.



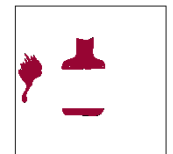
Step 2,
Using tan colored thread, stitch brush, bottle and rib detail.



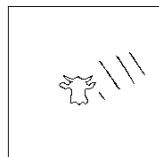
Step 3,
Stitch brush metal detail using dark gray or blue thread.



Step 4,
Stitch ribs using brown thread.



Step 5,
Using burgundy or red colored thread, stitch BBQ sauce.



Step 6,
Stitch grill marks and label detail using black thread.

Stitch grilling utensils using gray colored thread.




Step 2,
Stitch handles using brown thread.




Step 3,

Stitch 'Q' and flame using red thread.




Step 6,
Stitch detail and outline using black thread.



Stitch mustard bottle using yellow thread.






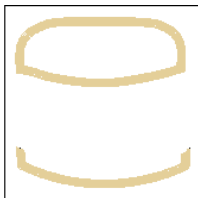
1) WS thread, sew placement stitches



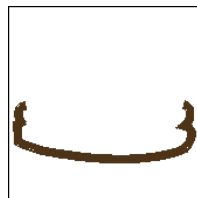
2) Place hamburger fabric, match thread, sew tack down. Cut close to stitching.



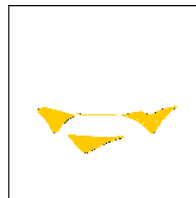
3) Place bun fabric, match thread, sew tack down and detail. Cut close to stitching.



4) Continue with matching thread and sew satin stitches.



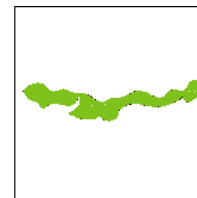
5) Place "hamburger" thread in the needle and sew satin stitches.



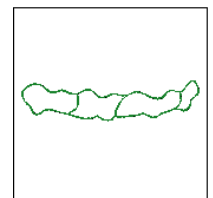


1) WS thread, sew placement stitches




2) Place bun fabric, match thread, sew tack down. Cut close to stitching.




3) Continue with matching thread and sew satin stitches.




4) Place hot dog/sausage fabric. Match thread. Sew tack down. Cut close to stitching.




5) Thread of your choice for grill marks.


1) WS thread, sew placement stitches




2) Place white fabric and sew tack down stitches with WS thread. Trim close to stitches.
