Measure the '1 Inch' box. It must measure 1". If it does not on first try, look for something that says <u>Actual Size</u>, <u>No Scaling</u>, or words that mean to not change the size in any way.

Stain Coasters

1.) Hoop <u>stabilizer</u> . Place <u>water soluble</u> <u>thread</u> in the needle and embroidery bobbin thread in the bobbin. Sew placement stitches.	2.) Place Coaster <u>Pre-cut HOOPShape®</u> over placement stitches. Sew tack down using <u>water soluble thread</u> .	3.) Place <u>Front Fabric</u> right side up and sew tack down using <u>water soluble</u> <u>thread.</u>
4.) 4.) Conffee Chocolate Place <u>thread color of your choice</u> in the needle only and stitch the embroidery.	 5.) Place folded pieces of Backing Fabric over coaster with folded edges overlapping in the middle by approx. 1". Sew the seam using thread that matches your fabric. 	Remove from hoop. Carefully tear away stabilizer. Trim fabric 1/4" from basting stitch. Clip corners. Turn and press.

Beans To Brew Quilt Supply List

*For best use of Background fabric, cut as follows:

9" x width of fabric (wof), cut into two 9" x 9" and two $8\frac{3}{4}$ " x 4"

12" x wof, cut into four 12" x 9" and two 6" x 6"

6" x wof, cut one 6" x 6" and three 53/4" x 4"

Quilt requires 8" x 11" hoop

Additional Supplies to have on hand:

- 2/3 yd. Backing Fabric (used as a whole piece after blocks are assembled)
- Embroidery Thread
- Embroidery bobbin thread
- Superior Vanish Lite Thread

Beans to Brew Quilt Assembly

Layout your trimmed quilt blocks as shown. Sew them together into three vertical sections. We have color coded the vertical sections in the drawing shown on the right. Press seams open. Sew the vertical sections together and press seams open.


Press your backing fabric and layout on table with right side down. If desired, carefully spray with temporary spray adhesive such as Sulky KK2000. Center your quilt top over backing fabric and safety pin to backing fabric starting at center of quilt and working your way out.

Place your walking foot on your sewing machine. Place Superior Mono.poly Thread in the needle and thread in the bobbin that matches your backing fabric. Stitch in the ditch between each block. Trim backing fabric even with your quilt top. Place a hanging sleeve on your quilt if desired, bind and enjoy.
