

These giftable rompers are perfect for baby showers, cradles, and lots of warm cuddles.

A. Fold Infant Romper in half lengthwise. Press well with cool iron. Mark with a water-soluble or heat sensitive pen.



B. Measure **down** 6" from **top** of Romper. Mark with a water-soluble or heat sensitive pen.



C. Hoop No Show Mesh Stabilizer. Using a non-flammable, non-toxic, temporary adhesive spray, spray the stabilizer with a small amount of adhesive.

Note: Spray adhesive in location away from embroidery machine. Some sprays will leave a residue.
